The Supreme Court has underscored the critical role of interim injunctions in specific performance suits, emphasizing that the doctrine of lis pendens under Section 52 of the Transfer of Property Act, 1882, may not adequately safeguard a plaintiff's interests. Mahadevan explained that while lis pendens addresses property transfers during litigation, it might leave room for situations where equitable relief becomes...
