Scorching Heat Forces Delhi Court to Postpone Case Until November

In a surprising turn of events, a consumer court in Delhi has adjourned a case until November, citing unbearable summer heat and inadequate facilities. The courtroom, lacking both air conditioning and coolers, became an untenable environment for proceedings. During the hearing, President Suresh Kumar Gupta, along with members Harshali Kaur and Ramesh Chand Yadav, noted the extreme conditions: "Temperature is more than 40 degrees Celsius. There is too much heat..."

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
