In a significant ruling on the Specific Relief Act, 1963, the Supreme Court recently held that an execution court can entertain an application under Section 28 for either rescission of a contract or an extension of the time to deposit the balance sale consideration—provided it is the same court that passed the original decree. This decision came after a case involving a suit for specific performance, where the decree-holder sought...
