Supreme Court Clears Path for Post-Deadline Arbitration Extensions

In a significant ruling, the Supreme Court has held that the deadline for passing an arbitral award, as prescribed under Section 29A of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, can be extended even after the statutory eighteen-month limit. This clarification came in response to a batch of appeals, with the Court stating that the termination of an arbitral mandate under Section 29A is not set in stone. Section 29A outlines that...
