Supreme Court Holds Firm on TET Mandate, Grants Teachers Final One-Year Breather

The Supreme Court has declined to reopen its landmark ruling that made the Teacher Eligibility Test (TET) compulsory for serving school teachers seeking to remain in service and secure promotions. While refusing to review the judgment, the Court provided a limited reprieve by extending the compliance deadline by one additional year, pushing it to August 31, 2028. A Bench comprising Justice Dipankar Datta and Justice Manmohan dismissed a series of...
