Objection Deadline Begins With Awareness of Arbitration Award, Not Formal Notice

In a pivotal interpretation of the Arbitration Act, 1940, the Supreme Court ruled that the 30-day limitation period for filing objections to an arbitral award commences when a party becomes aware of the award, rather than upon receiving formal notice of its issuance. The case revolved around an arbitral award issued on September 21, 2022. The respondent, though informally aware of the award's existence on that date, received formal notice...

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
