1. Vide order dated 22.07.2024 passed by this Court, Mr. Vishal Sharma, learned DSGI was directed to report instructions from the respondents regarding retrieval of dead body of deceased-Harsh Nagotra from the Pakistan.

Today when this PIL was taken up for hearing, Mr. Vishal Sharma, learned DSGI submitted that he has instructions from the respondents to submit that the body of deceased-Harsh Nagotra has been handed over to family members after its retrieval from the Pakistan. He further submitted that according to respondents the body of deceased-Harsh Nagotra was cremated yesterday by the family members as per Hindu rites.

3. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the respondents, this PIL has been rendered infructuous and the same is, accordingly, disposed of.
