VACATION COURT

P.C. :-

1. This matter was circulated in vacation by the Petitioner praying for the following relief:-



- "f. Pending the hearing and final disposal of the present Petition, restrain Respondent from holding a personal hearing until the Petitioner is furnished with all relevant material and provided a fair opportunity to respond."
- 2. It was submitted by the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner that hearing was scheduled on 30th October 2025 in terms of show cause notice issued to the petitioner and that if the hearing is held, great prejudice will be caused to the petitioners.
- 3. After hearing learned counsels for the parties, when this Court was not inclined to grant any ad-interim relief, learned counsel appearing for the petitioners on instructions states that he would withdraw the petition and appear before the respondent No. 1 'under the protest'. He states that he may be given liberty to raise all contentions which are raised by him in the present petition before the respondent No.1.
- 4. He further states that in case the order is adverse to him, he may be given liberty to raise all contentions before the appropriate forum.



- 5. Mr. Bharucha, learned senior counsel appearing for the respondent No. 1 has no objection to this. Hence, the present Writ Petition is disposed of as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
- 6. Since the petition is withdrawn, this court does not comment upon the merits of the matter.
- 7. Since the petitioner does not press for the petition; same is disposed of as 'withdrawn'.
