Leave granted.

The appellant seeks regular bail in connection with FIR No.103/2026, dated 04.03.2026, registered with Police Station Sitalkuchi District - Cooch Behar, West Bengal for the offences punishable under Sections 3(5), 329(4), 351(3) and 64 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

We have heard the learned counsel appearing for the parties. The respondent No.2/complainant has been served.

Prima facie, it seems to us that the present case is one of a relationship turning sour. The appellant has been under incarceration for a period of seven months approximately. It is

submitted that the charge sheet has been filed in the present case.

Considering the aforesaid circumstances, we are inclined to set aside the impugned order and grant bail to the appellant.

Accordingly, the impugned order passed by the High Court stands set aside and the appellant is granted bail on such terms and conditions subject to the satisfaction of the concerned Trial Court.

The appeal stands allowed, accordingly.
