Civil Appeal No. 2785/2012

1. Having heard Mr. Narender Hooda, learned senior counsel appearing for the appellant - National Highways Authority of India and Mr. Sameer Parikh, learned counsel appearing for the respondent - Hindustan Construction Co. Ltd.

2. We are of the opinion that the National Company Law Appellate Tribunal has not committed any error in law or fact.

3. The civil appeal is, accordingly, dismissed and the accompanying interlocutory application(s), if any, stands disposed of.

Civil Appeal No. 2788/2012

1. Heard Mr. Sameer Parikh, learned counsel appearing for the appellant - Hindustan Construction Co. Ltd. and Mr. Narender Hooda, learned senior counsel appearing for the respondent - National Highways Authority of India.

2. The High Court, in exercise of its jurisdiction under Section 37 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act has interfered with the certain claims allowed by the arbitral tribunal. In order to satisfy ourselves about the conclusions drawn by the High Court, we took the assistance of Mr. Sameer Parekh and Mr. Narender Hooda, learned counsels appearing for the appellant and the respondent to go through the findings of the Arbitral Tribunal, as affirmed in Section 34 application.

3. Having considered the matter in detail, though we may not agree with the reasoning adopted by the High Court exercising jurisdiction under Section 37 of the Act, we are of the opinion that the eventual conclusions are correct and based on record.

4. In this view of the matter, the civil appeal stands dismissed.
